Rowland's Row Farm was started by Joe and Dani Rowland in 2010 as a part of the Elma C. Lomax Incubator Farm. In the early days it was just one row of vegetables...Rowland's Row. Since then, the farm has grown into our 18 acre homestead in Gold Hill.

Rowland's Row Farm proudly grows a variety of seasonal fruits and vegetables without the use of any synthetic chemicals and Non-GMO, all natural, free range, antibiotic and hormone free, pastured broilers, layers and ducks.

Benefits of CSA membership

- A seasonal supply of fresh, local, competitively priced produce and farm products
 - A direct relationship with the farmer producing your food
 - An opportunity to learn about agriculture and local ecosystems
- A community-building connection with farmers and other CSA members

Benefits of a CSA to the farmer

- CSA shares are sold before the harvest season to provide funds to the farmers for operating expenses.
- A CSA spreads the risk of farming among a community larger than a single farm.

****PLEASE NOTE**** As a CSA member you purchase a share of our harvest, BUT you also share the risk of reduced vegetable harvest due to crop failure. We are in our 7th season and although experienced, we are still learning and mother nature is not always on our side. Our goal is to provide a bountiful box of fresh produce for our members. However, vegetable availability is always subject to weather, disease, and pests. We grow a variety of vegetables and fruits to help spread the risk of crop failure, but there can always be growing setbacks. There is always a chance of a complete crop failure through some natural disaster that causes complete crop loss. **CSA members receive first priority over farmers markets and wholesale orders in the event of any crop problems.**

Vegetable share prices are based on a full 12 weeks of vegetables. The amount of vegetables in your box each week may vary depending but the total value of your CSA will total a minimum of \$300.
